

CALL FOR AUDITIONS: We're Looking for GIGS and BITs for the 2015 Cappies Gala!

Cappies critics and theatre students can audition to be a GIG (Girl in Gown) or BIT (Boy in Tux) for the National Capital Area Cappies Gala on June 7 at the Kennedy Center. GIGs and BITs are the students who escort VIP presenters onto the Kennedy Center stage to present Cappies trophies to winners. GIGs and BITs also serve many other roles onstage and backstage at The Kennedy Center and are an integral part of the Cappies Gala. Don't miss this opportunity to be a part of this very special event!

Auditions for the 2015 NCA Cappies GIGs and BITs are on Wednesday, May 27, at Robinson Secondary School Black Box Theatre at 7 p.m. Girls must bring and model their formal gown (dresses must have straps) and shoes that they plan to wear to the Gala. Boys do not have to wear tuxes to the audition, but they must have access to a tuxedo for the Gala.

We need approximately 30 men and women to fill a variety of roles onstage and backstage. In choosing GIGs and BITs, priority will be given to returning GIGs and BITs, followed by Cappies Critics, followed by theatre students.
